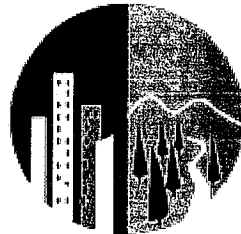

AND COLLABORATION**




