SECRETARIAT

Tourism Relief Fund

WHAT: Funding to support adapting operations to meet public health requirements. Contributions to Indigenous entities (not generating profits) will normally be non-repayable, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

WHO: Tourism businesses and organizations that cater mainly to visitors, including band councils and other Indigenous organizations and cooperatives.

WHEN: Until March 31, 2023.

How: Read the Applicant Guide to check your business's eligibility and submit the Application Form online. Call Western Diversification's BC office for assistance at 604-666-6256 or email wd.bc-cb.deo@canada.ca.

Canada Emergency Wage Subsidy (CEWS) – Extended & the Canada Recovery Hiring Program (CRHP)

WHAT: The subsidy amount is based on the business's revenue drop due to COVID.

WHO: Canadian businesses that have experienced a revenue drop due to COVID of at least 10%; have a Canadian Revenue Agency payroll account on March 15, 2020; meet the qualifications for 'type of employer'. For each claim period between June 6 and September 25, 2021, you can apply for either the CEWS or the CRHP depending on which subsidy gives you the higher amount.

WHEN: CEWS is available until October 2021. CRHP is available until November 20, 2021.

HOW: Compare the CRHP and the CEWS to **determine your eligibility** and apply **online for CRHP** and **CEWS**. Call CEWS at 1-833-966-2099 and CRHP at 1-800-959-5525 for assistance with eligibility requirements and calculations. Call CRA at 1-800-959-5525 for assistance with 'My Business Account' access.

NOTE: The subsidy does not renew automatically. You need to reapply after each 4-week period.

Own-Source Revenue in Indigenous Communities Initiative

WHAT: Funding to Indigenous communities that have experienced own-source revenue declines during the COVID-19 pandemic.

WHO: First Nations, Inuit and Métis communities, self-governing and Modern Treaty First Nations, and Tribal Councils or community governments that can demonstrate a decline, for example, as a year-over-year loss using audited consolidated financial statements.

WHEN: Until August 31, 2021.

How: ISC BC Region will be sending out a call for application. The call will provide the application and contact details. ISC BC Region's email address is **aadnc.bcecdev.aandc@canada.ca**.

NOTE: The call will provide information on how to access help and financial assistance to fill in the application.



Canada Emergency Rent Subsidy (CERS) - Extended

WHAT: A subsidy to cover part of the commercial rent or property expenses, payable directly to qualifying renters and property owners, without requiring the participation of landlords.

WHO: Eligible Canadian businesses, non-profit organizations, or charities who have seen a drop in revenue due to the COVID-19 pandemic that meet 1 of 4 conditions.

WHEN: September 27, 2020 until September 25, 2021.

How: Check your **business's eligibility** and **apply online** through your Canadian Revenue Agency 'My Business Account'. Call CRA at 1-800-959-5525 for assistance with CERS and 'My Business Account' access.

Indigenous Community Business Fund (ICBF)

WHAT: Provides non-repayable financial contributions to support Indigenous community-owned businesses whose revenues have been affected by COVID-19. Supports businesses that do not qualify for other federal government COVID-19 relief measures.

WHO: Indigenous community-owned on or off reserve, for-profit business and microbusinesses located in BC; in operation since October 1, 2019; negatively financially impacted by COVID-19.

WHEN: Applications for funding are accepted until funding runs out.

HOW: Check your business's **eligibility, download the application form and apply via email** to **aadnc.bcecdev.aandc@canada.ca**. Call the ISC BC Region Office at 604-562-6865 for assistance.

NOTE: the fund supports the operation of the business as well as costs to support the adaptation, planning and reopening of a business.

Highly Affected Sectors Credit Availability Program (HASCAP) Guarantee

Financial institutions are administering the Highly Affected Sectors Credit Availability Program (HASCAP) Guarantee, a low-interest loan of \$25,000 to \$1 million for businesses heavily impacted by COVID. The Guarantee is available until December 31, 2021.
